

# HYA Scenario Guide

1-3 refers to the weathering state of the bogies where 1 is light and 3 is heavy.

The liveries are controlled by autonumbering then by script so if the script has a combination like **371001a**, it will show the livery (and micro details) for **371001a**.

If you change the **a** to another letter without changing the number in accordance, the livery may load but the micro details will not. If you put in a combination that is not in the list below, you'll get a blurry placeholder texture.

## Consist examples

Nacco Sand hoppers are used from Grain (Kent) to Brentford Town (London), Neasden Charrington, Harlow Mill, Colnbrook & Bow (London).

Touax hoppers (371xxx and 6791) are used on Arcow - Pendleton and Bredbury (<https://flic.kr/p/2nNw63o>).

Nacco Aggregates hoppers are sometimes seen in Peak Forest trains (<https://flic.kr/p/2nUfjLC>, 3<sup>rd</sup> hopper), or Arcow - Hunslet & Rylstone – Hunslet, Hull Dairycoates trains (<https://flic.kr/p/2nRqjio>). Ex Fastline, VTG Tarmac, & Touax (6791) hoppers also make an appearance on the latter trains.

Cemex hoppers (371xxx and 6791) are used on Peak Forest trains (<https://flic.kr/p/2nSkvFR>).

VTG hoppers (6955) are used on Bardon Hill – Tinsley, Ferme Park, Harlow Mill, Angerstein Wharf, Colnbrook, Bow (London), Theale, Neasden Charrington, Grain (Kent) - Ferme Park, Angerstein Wharf, Neasden Charrington, Colnbrook, Bow (London), Avonmouth West Yard – Colnbrook and Portbury Auto – Bow, Colnbrook (<https://flic.kr/p/2nmpEAh>).
